## Honoring Our Living Legends

***1 Timothy 5:17 (KJV) ‘Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine’.***

It is a common practice these days when people we love and respect are called home to glory for people to show up massively at their funeral. People would write and make excellent comments about their lives and impacts. Folks will spend extravagantly in order to honor their dead heroes and travel long distances to be present at their homegoing.

The unfortunate part of this is the fact that their heroes never knew how much they meant to these people while they lived. Some may even have died from depression and broken heartedness that their work was never appreciated. I wonder where we learnt this value!

This is a trend we must reverse. Believers ought to celebrate their living legends not their dead saints. We ought to let our leaders who have made impact in our lives know how much we appreciate their contributions in our lives. The dead cannot hear compliments but the

living. What is the value of expensive clothes we wear at their funeral and the parties we throw on their behalf?

There is power in encouragement. Everyone at some point in their life benefit from it; from the President to the Pope and the street Peasants. Leaders that work hard and lead well as Paul admonished should be appreciated and given double honor. Our words, compliments, gifts, and support can go a long way to sustain such leaders especially in their low moments.

We are told that hundreds of pastors and spiritual leaders quit every week across the world. For many, their reason was simply that they felt discouraged! They did not realize the impact of their work because nobody told them so. Then the enemy hits hard on them. Some are even criticized and abused by the followers they labor hard to serve. They are taken for granted, overworked, underpaid, and poorly appreciated. Some church members abuse and misuse their pastors. Same pastor who named their kids, married them and their children, buried their dead and comforted them in their difficult times. Yet not a single note of appreciation, a text, a token of gift had ever left their hands to their pastor.

The work of a pastor is indeed undervalued. He is the counselor when folks are confused, he is the comforter when hearts are broken, he is the doctor when people are ill, he is the financial adviser when members are broke. He is expected to be available 24/7 to respond to call from parishioners even when he is on vacation, some even questioned why should he be on vacation when people are perishing. People get mad when they cannot reach the pastor, some even quit the church because the pastor did not return their calls on time.

Pastors have seemingly endless responsibilities on their plate that include responding 24/7 to calls from church members. In any given week, a pastor may deliver a Sunday sermon, lead bible-study groups, develop



new programs, visit shut-ins, perform last-rites, minister to youth and plan a mission trip, countless hours on their knees, and innumerable phone calls. Despite the long hours and emotional intensity of the job, pastors are underpaid and undervalued.

Yes, their rewards will be great in heaven, but it is even better if they can start receiving part payment on earth.

So what can you do? Text a comment or send a note after a message that blessed you, remember to pray for them, acknowledge their birthdays, send a gift, help babysit their kids, run errands for them when needed, speak a word of encouragement and so on.

Let's appreciate our living legends rather than celebrate our dead heroes.

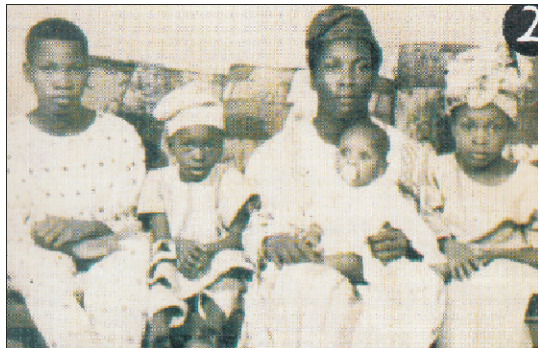
### REV. ( DR.) KUNLE ADESINA

**R**ev (Dr) Kunle Adesina fondly called “Papa” by his congregation was born on 2<sup>nd</sup> January 1957 in Abeokuta into a Muslim family of Alhaji Folorunsho Ishola Adesina and Mrs Esther Olawunmi Adesina, but grew up with his grandmother, Mrs Stella Akinola, who was a Christian in Lagos. He had his primary education at Ago-Ijaye Methodist Primary School, Ebute-Metta and the Secondary education at Methodist Boys High school, Lagos he later proceeded for Advanced level certificate (“A Level”) at Federal School of Arts and Science, Victoria Island, Lagos. He studied Pharmacy at the University of Lagos.

He met the Lord in February 1977 during his “A” level studies he received the call into Ministry while still studying at in the University. He has been preaching the gospel both within and outside the University Campuses from his school days. He did his internship as a Pharmacist at the Ogun State Hospital, Sokenu,

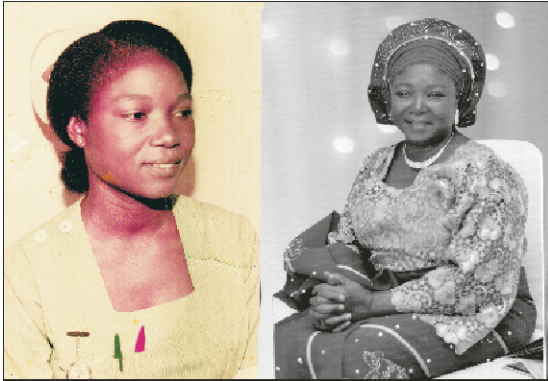
### PASTOR (MRS) 'REMI ADESINA

She met her husband at the College of Medicine, UNILAG Christian Fellowship Group (CFG), Idi-Araba, Lagos where they both worshipped during their sojourn at the institution. They got married in 1986.



“Mama's” professional career spanned over twenty (20) years as a Psychiatric Nurse at Aro, Abeokuta, before receiving a call into the full time ministry in the year 2000 when she resigned her appointment to join her husband in the global vision.

She is currently based in London, United Kingdom where she jointly with the UK overseer oversee some of the branches of the Church in Europe. Pastor (Mrs) Remi Adesina is a Pastor by calling, an icon in the vineyard of God. A woman of

great virtue and a mother with a large heart.

FAMILY HOUSE AT AMOLASO AREA, IGBEIN, ABEOKUTA, OGUN STATE, NIGERIA.

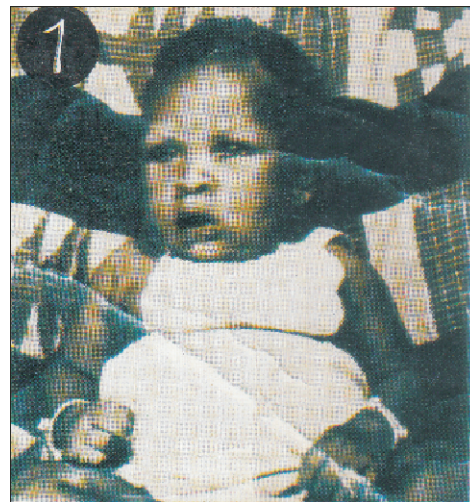
*Growing Up*



Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 1957, exactly 2 O'clock was an exceptional and a memorable day as a bright star, an icon was born the same month Martin Luther King (Jrn.) a man noted for his outstanding address, "I have a Dream" was born. What a correlation!. That day was just like any other day, little did his mother Madam Esther Olawunmi Adesina and her husband Alhaji Folorunsho Ishola Adesina knew just how the birth of their first son, was going to bring their family to lime light and impact future generations and the whole world.

What made the birth of Kunle (as he is sometimes called by his mum) an unforgettable one is his divine purpose, the message he carried for his generations, the unique gospel of Jubilee, which means freedom, liberty, deliverance and liberation to the captives.

The entire Adesina dynasty was also not aware of the significance of the birth of their beloved son and the season he was born into. As the whole world was just heralding the entrance into the new year, 1957, and everybody was still in the joyful mood of a new year and a new dawn, the Adesina's were receiving double joy and celebrations for generational change. Prophecy was being fulfilled from Abeokuta, the cradle of Christianity, Egbaland which played prominent roles in the promotion of Christianity in Nigeria as Cathedral Church of St. Peters, Ake, Abeokuta, was the first Church in Nigeria built in honour of the first missionary to Egba-land, Rev. Henry Townsend in the year 1898.





The young baby was named Adekunle Fatai Adesina by his father according to Islamic faith of the father. Born into a close knitted family, he grew up among his relatives being the first child of the family of nine, four boys and five girls.

Since the formative years of a Child is very crucial to what he becomes in life, destiny ensured that the young Adesina had to stay with his grandmother, Madam Stella Akinola, who was a devoted Christian for the first ten years of his life just like the way the young Timothy was raised by his grandmother Lois.

Growing up with the grandmother was a divine arrangement as the young kunle recalls many lessons he learnt which eventually contributed in no small measure to what he is today.

Living in Lagos suburb, Ebute Metta, at this time was very strategic in God's agenda for the young 'Kunle, but the grace of God was evident upon him. It was at this period that he attended Ago-Ijaye Methodist Primary School, Ebute-Metta and later Methodist Boys High School, Lagos. After his Secondary School Education, he later attended Federal School of Arts and Science, Victorial Island, Lagos for his 'A' Levels programme before he finally got admission to the prestigious, University of Lagos, (First among the Equals) for his Pharmacy degree in October, 1979.

Just like the Lord said that I have found David, with my holy oil have I anointed him. The Lord himself found Kunle, at the Federal School of Arts and Science in January, 1977 and this was the beginning of a great revolution in the Adesina's family through whom the course of eternity of many family members and other destinies are being shaped.

In spite of the stiff opposition to his newly found faith, which was so severed as the father threatened to eject him out of the house, the young Kunle never waiver or shaken in His faith in GOD until God Himself took

control and the father opined that if it is God's will, he would come back to Islamic religion. Oh ! what a faithful God we serve!.

As the old saying goes, that the bird does not fly with a wing. In the same vein, at the heart of Ile-Ife, Osun State, Nigeria, the cradle of Yoruba race, a mother like Deborah and Abigail in the person of Remi Adesina nee Fabunmi was born the 10<sup>th</sup> of March, 1959. This woman was divinely prepared and endowed for this global vision as can be attested to her wisdom, maturity and understanding in handling naughty issues relating to big ministry like this. Mama has a strong quality of positive influence in the lives of young believers and newcomers to the Church. She makes you feel welcome, appreciated and loved when you come into her company. Indeed, she has been a great support and pillar beside her husband and this global commission



# *The Call*

**A**s the Bible says “ For you see your calling brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God has chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;.... I Cor I :26-27

The young Adesina received the call into the ministry while still in School. The vision became clearer when he got to Part three. Before then, Pastor Adesina had been preaching the Gospel both within and outside University arena. This was also confirmed by many notable men of God.

However, some leaders and destiny helpers were instrumental in the build up to the vision and the calling of Pastor Adesina. Prominent among whom were Rev (Dr) Tunde Jooda, then a Medical Student at the University of Lagos, UNILAG) now the Founder and General Overseer of Christ Chapel, International

Churches, Lagos. He was the first person that exposed the Young Kunle into the basic foundational Knowledge of the word of God while also inspired him to the teaching and books of great men of God such as Kenneth Copeland, Oral Robert, Kenneth Hagin etc. It was while in the University that Pastor Adesina received his calling and knew assuredly that he would be a pastor, even though, 'how' and 'where' was not immediately known to him.

Amazingly, even though Rev Kunle was born and bred in Lagos, and all his youthful life had been in Lagos, when it was time for God to fulfill the calling, he was moved out of Lagos by divine providence to Abeokuta ( which coincidentally ,was his home town), where he did his internship in 1984 with the Ogun State Health Board and was posted to the General Hospital, Ijaye, Sokenu ,Abeokuta, thereafter continued his services with the Hospital till December, 1989 before finally resigning into full time Ministry.

It was while working at the Hospital as a Pharmacist that he received the burden to start a Christian fellowship, named Jubilee Christian Fellowship Ministry, which started at one of the classrooms at Rev'd Kuti Memorial Primary School, Isabo-Abeokuta on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January, 1987 which is now the Ministry Founders Day. The fellowship which later metamorphosed into full fledged Church, named Jubilee Christian Church International by 15<sup>th</sup> March , 1992 ,has since moved from the temporary site to its permanent abode, at Isale Abetu, Abeokuta, sitting on a large expanse of land with auditorium which can sit up to 2,500 worshippers, is now the Headquarters of the Church with close to 40 (forty ) branches across the globe.

May be you too are wondering why God seems to be silent for 28 years to the prayer request of this great man and woman of God, in spite of several testimonies of God's goodness in the life of members of his Ministry, yet the only answer God gave for this period was, wait!wait! and wait!.That explains the practical dealings of God with His vessels.

Nevertheless, at the appointed time of God, He made all things beautiful, visited them and remembered them for good. 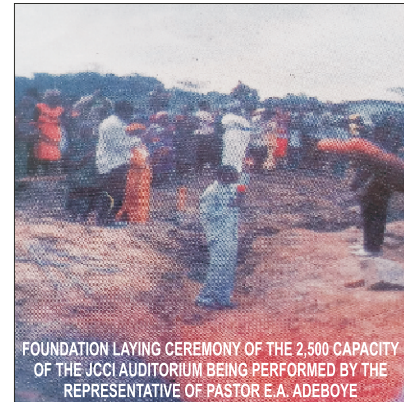
